Eco Global Gears Up for Higher Than Expected Demand for Its Kit Houses

Once the people are trained, Eco Global expects to expand this program to other cities. Daniel Correa stated that "the advantage of these programs is that government vouchers can be issued to purchase the home for the full amount of the purchase price. Therefore, the buyer is not only pre-approved, but the voucher pays for the house at its completion." The market potential in Tijuana may be as many as five thousand houses.
