Eco Global, a Specialized Home Builder, Waives Licensing Fees to Individuals, Builders and Contractors in Haiti

SPRING VALLEY, CA--(Marketwire - January 26, 2010) - Eco Global Corporation (OTCBB: ECOG), a company specializing in the design, manufacturing and building of both small and large-scale low cost housing units made of its "INCABLOCKS," announced today that the company will waive its licensing fees to individuals, builders and contractors using "INCABLOCKS" in the world-wide efforts to provide relief to the people and country of Haiti. The company owns a U.S. patent covering the "INCABLOCK Construction System," a patented concrete block design that is not only stronger than conventional concrete blocks, but is also fire resistant, termite free, and resistant to both high winds and earthquakes. Users of the "INCABLOCK Construction System" can construct "INCABLOCK" housing five times faster than conventional block, with a stronger interlocking connection. "INCABLOCK" is the ideal block construction system for Haiti because its interlocking block design is far superior to monolithic block construction and, importantly, "INCABLOCK" structures can be built with unskilled laborers.

The company is planning to introduce its "Saver Shelter Line," a kit house of totally modular, green and unlimited self sustaining houses, to Haiti, offering models ranging from 36, 50, 72 and 100 square meter projects, with 200 and 400 Watts Solar Electric infrastructure, and the incorporation of gray water collection with a Passive Solar Design. Using these features, the "INCABLOCK Saver Shelter Line" saves water, uses less energy, and can be built using non-skilled labor or even by the homeowner(s) themselves.
